North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Raymond Edward Shaffer, 51, who entered into rest September 2, 2021, will be conducted Tuesday morning at 11 o'clock from Grace United Methodist Church, Rev. 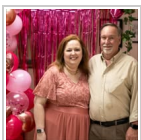

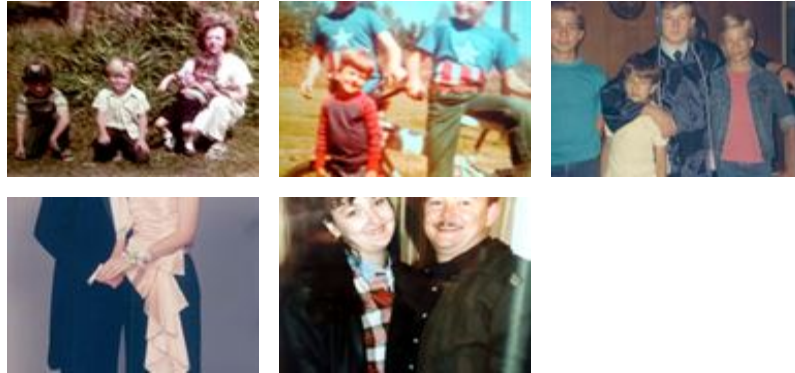
