



## Rev. Talmadge Belding, Jr.

August 10, 1943 - June 9, 2008

North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Rev. Talmadge D. Belding Jr., 64, of Timberidge Drive, North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest June 9, 2008, will be conducted Thursday morning at 11 o'clock from Grace United Methodist Church. Dr. James C. Rev. Belding was a lifelong resident of North Augusta and son of the late Talmadge D. Belding, Sr.. Belding was a graduate of Wofford College, Erskine Theological Seminary and was retired from the E.I. DuPont Company and Westinghouse at the Savannah River Site with thirty-five years of service.
