Mr. Crawford was a native of Augusta, having made North Augusta his residence for the past 44 years. He was a Charter Member of Burns Memorial United Methodist Church, a U.S. Marine Corp Veteran of the Korean Conflict, a member and Past Commander of the Brig. Gen. Barnard E. Bee Camp of the Sons of the Confederacy, a former member of the Midland Valley High School Stadium Committee, served on the football Chain Crew, and was a retired shift Supervisor at DSM Chemical Company. Mr. Crawford was the grandfather of the late Sarah Tuten.
