Mr. Logan was born October 4, 1944, to the late Walter Percy Logan and Margaret Riley Logan. He was a native of Augusta, GA, and retired as a machine tender from Augusta Newsprint with 38 years of service. Mr. Logan was a friend to everyone and never met a stranger. He will be fondly remembered for his wit and sense of humor, always telling jokes and bringing smiles to everyone he knew. Mr. Logan was preceded in death by his beloved dog and best friend, Roo.

Mrs. Logan was born August 9, 1949, to the late Glyn Lanier Holton and Christine Merriett Holton. She was a native of North Augusta, SC and was a devoted wife, mother, and grandmother. As a dedicated homemaker, she adored her family, especially her grandchildren.
