He was a past commander and life member of the Savannah River Power Squadron, a former Instructor Trainer for the American Red Cross, a member of the Senior Men's Club of Aiken, a member of the Academy of Life Long Learning and was a Meals on Wheels volunteer for the Council on Aging. Mr. Hunt attended the First Christian Church of Aiken.
