



Robert W. "Bob" Clark

April 11, 1941 - January 27, 2024

North Augusta, SC – Mr. Robert Wayne “Bob” Clark, 82, of Rapids Court, passed away January 27, 2024. Memorial Services will be conducted Saturday afternoon, February 3rd, at 2 o’clock at Fairview Presbyterian Church. Dr. Allen M. Thompson officiating. A reception will follow in the church fellowship hall. A private interment will take place in the Fairview Presbyterian Church Columbarium.

Bob was born April 11, 1941 in Sumter, SC, to the late Walter Monroe Clark and Ethel Mae Smith Clark. He received a degree in Chemical Engineering from Georgia Tech in 1963 and worked for several agricultural chemical companies, including PCS Nitrogen of Augusta. Bob served as manager of the Ammonia Plant from 1977 to 1993. He spent the last 17 years of his career in technical sales with Johnson-Matthey Corporation, officially retiring in 2006. Following retirement, he continued to work for Johnson-Matthey as a consultant until the end of 2010.

Bob was active in Boy Scouts in his early years. He worked with Habitat for Humanity for 5 years in Texas and was a member of the North Augusta Planning Commission for many years. He was active in the American Institute of Chemical Engineers, serving on the International Ammonia Safety Symposium for over 22 years. He was a faithful Christian and an active member of Fairview Presbyterian Church. He served as Elder and Deacon in

several churches as he and Carol moved to different cities.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Walter M. Clark, III. Surviving family members left to cherish his memory include his beloved wife of 60 years, Carolyn Lown Clark; two children, Robert Wayne, Jr. (Melanie) of Port Orange, FL, and Jill Warner (Kirk) of North Canton, OH; five grandchildren, Matt Warner (Lexy), David Warner, Jacob Warner, Lauren Meyerhoffer (Brandon), and Ryan Clark. He is also survived by 3 great grandchildren: Brayden, Rosy and Maddy.

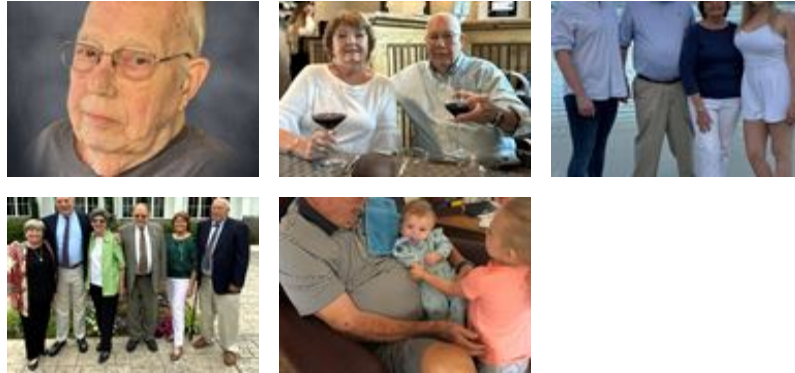
