Aiken, SC—A Celebration of Life for Mr. Robert E. "Bob" Hajec, 66, of 4 Woodwind Way, Aiken, SC, who entered into rest May 24, 2014, will be conducted at the residence May 27, 2014, Tuesday evening at 6 o'clock. Bob was a native of Corry, Pennsylvania, having made Aiken his home for the past twenty-one years as an accountant with Savannah River Nuclear Solutions. He was a graduate of Corry High School and received his Bachelor of Science in Accounting from Pennsylvania State University in 1969. Upon graduation he accepted an auditor position with Price Waterhouse, and then began his forty-three year career with Westinghouse Electric Corporation living in Buffalo, Cleveland, Chicago, Pittsburgh, Baltimore, and Aiken. Bob, an avid Penn State fan who enjoyed drawing, poetry, woodworking, and England, was devoted to work, God, and family.
