He always sought to help others. Each year he would play Santa Claus for patients at local nursing homes and did whatever he could to help his fellow man. As a co-founder of Remedy Health Career Center, he was passionate about quality Certified Nurse Aide education. He worked to raise awareness about many major health issues, including esophageal cancer of which he so bravely fought. Mr. Kiernan was preceded in death by his brother, Paul Timothy Kiernan.
