Mr. Lamm was a native of Spartanburg, SC, having made North Augusta his home for over 60 years. He was an active member of First Baptist Church of North Augusta, where he was a member of the Strom Fellowship. He was also a member of the Joyous Seniors at Sweetwater Baptist Church. Mr. Lamm served as a Sargent in the U.S. Army during the Korean War and was a member of the Jessie C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post 71. He was the formerly employed with Lee Tire and Rubber Company and retired after many years of service as owner and operator of the North Augusta Motel. Following his retirement, he worked closely with Grace United Methodist Church while employed with MYD Services. Mr. Lamm was preceded in death by his wife, Peggy Foster Lamm; his parents, Andrew E. and Lillian W. Lamm, a brother, Dr. Ronald Lamm and a granddaughter, Lily Marie Lamm.
