Melbourne, FL—Graveside Memorial Services for Mr. Robert Seely Overton, 77, who died September 7, 2023, after an extended bout with Parkinson's Disease, will be conducted Wednesday, January 17, 2024, at 11 o'clock in the Westover Memorial Park. Reverend David Arnoldt officiating.

Mr. Overton was born June 13, 1946, in Atlanta, Georgia and his family moved to Tokyo, Japan when he was very young. His family eventually moved to North Augusta, South Carolina where he graduated from North Augusta High School and Augusta College. He had a long and successful career in sales, ultimately retiring from Ciba Vision of the Novartis Corporation as a sales director. Mr. Overton was a member of St. John the Evangelist Church of Melbourne, Florida. He was preceded in death by his parents, Harry B. and Mamie Elliott Overton.
