



## Robert Taylor "Bobby" Williams

October 1, 1954 - September 7, 2024

Robert Taylor Williams, affectionately known as Bobby, passed away peacefully at Hilton Head Hospital on September 7, 2024, at the age of 69. Born on October 1, 1954, to Clinton Walter Williams and Doris Taylor Williams, Bobby was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and friend. In his final moments, he was surrounded by his beloved wife of 37 years, Linda Rae Williams, his children, Brandi Williams Edmonds and Robert Taylor Williams II, and his bonus daughter, Melinda Hodge.

Bobby dedicated 30 years of his life as a lineman with SCE&G, where his hard work, dedication, and camaraderie were admired by his colleagues, who also fondly remember his famous "B sandwiches." After his well-earned retirement, Bobby embraced the simpler pleasures in life—relaxing, spending quality time with his family and church friends where he was a member of Warren Baptist Church, and lovingly caring for Linda. He was known for his kind and generous heart, his infectious sense of humor, and the joy he brought to everyone around him. Bobby always had a joke to tell and delighted in making others laugh. Whether trying new restaurants, catching a movie, doing his beloved celebrity impersonations—his Willie Nelson impression was a crowd favorite—or looking forward to his annual beach trips, Bobby's zest for life was evident to all who knew him.

Bobby is survived by his devoted wife, Linda; his daughter, Brandi Edmonds

(Brian); his son, Robert Taylor Williams II. He was the proud grandfather of Lainey Elisabeth Williams and Robert Taylor Williams III (Ty). Additionally, he is survived by his beloved bonus children: Roberta Gordon (Israel), Paul Avery (Cathy), Wayne Avery (Ching), Melinda Hodge; along with a host of bonus grandchildren, great-grandchildren, cousins, several nieces and nephews, extended family, his cat Chumley, and his "grand-dogs". 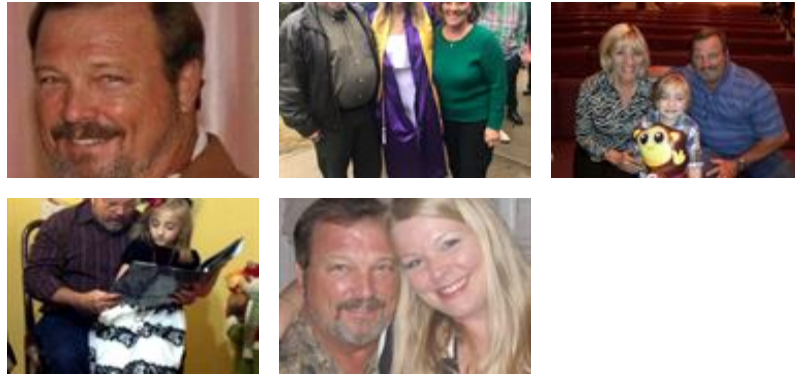
