Beech Island, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Romie “Bob” Estep, 89, who entered into rest May 12, 2016, will be held Sunday afternoon at 3 o’clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel. Dr. E. Finley Limehouse and Rev. Bert Baynham officiating. Interment in Pineview Memorial Gardens.

Mr. Estep was a native of West Virginia having made Beech Island his home for the past 62 years. He was a devoted Christian and charter member of Heights Baptist Church, Beech Island, where he served as a Deacon. Mr. Estep was a US Army Veteran and retired as an electrician at E.I. DuPont with 36 years of service. He coached North Augusta Optimist League Youth Basketball, served as one of the first members of the Beech Island Volunteer Fire Department and enjoyed golf, hunting and Clemson Football. Mr. Estep was a loving husband, father and grandfather who was devoted to his family. He was preceded in death by six brothers and four sisters.

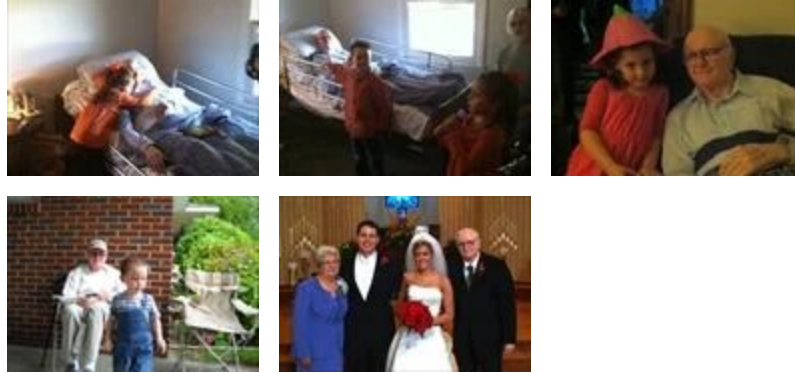

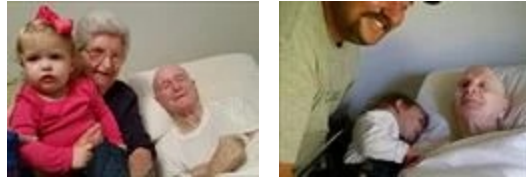

I am so sorry for the loss of your Husband, Father, Grandfather, Great Grandfather, and friend.

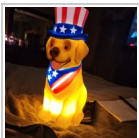

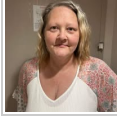
