North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Mr. Ronald E. Wheatley, 80, who entered into rest September 5, 2020, will be conducted Tuesday afternoon at 4 o'clock at Sweetwater Baptist Church with Dr. Paul W. Noe officiating. He was a U.S. Air Force veteran, a Mason and an ordained Deacon. Mr. Wheatley was an active member of Sweetwater Baptist Church and retired from Georgia-Pacific as a corporate pilot with over 30 years of service. He was a gifted craftsman, who enjoyed restoring vintage cars and woodworking, using his talents to make quality furniture and cypress clocks for family and friends. Mr. Wheatley will be fondly remembered as a Christian man who adored his family. His greatest pleasures were the times his great-grandchildren would visit him to enjoy cookies, soda and ice cream. Mr. Wheatley was preceded in death by his wife of almost 60 years, Frances J. Wheatley; and his parents, Benjamin Walter and Helga Lange Wheatley.

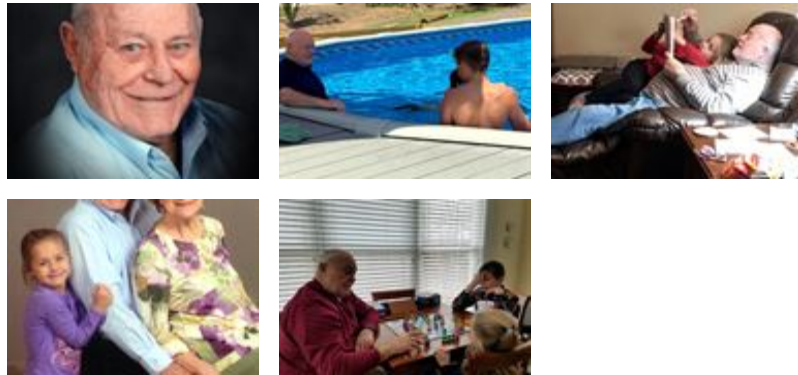
