



## Ruby Jayne Wallace

August 7, 1930 - July 14, 2024

North Augusta, SC- Ruby Jayne Wallace, a servant of Christ, died peacefully on July 14, 2024. Funeral services will be held Monday, July 22nd, at 11 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel with Rev. Mark Sterling officiating. Interment will follow in Westover Memorial Park. The family will receive friends one hour prior at the funeral home.

Mrs. Wallace was born on August 7, 1930, to a farming family in southern Ohio where she learned the value of hard work and family. Following her formal education, she excelled in a banking career.
