North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Mr. Samuel Lee Stringer, 71, who entered into rest November 17, 2025, will be conducted Tuesday morning, November 25, 2025, at 11 o'clock from Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church, Rev. 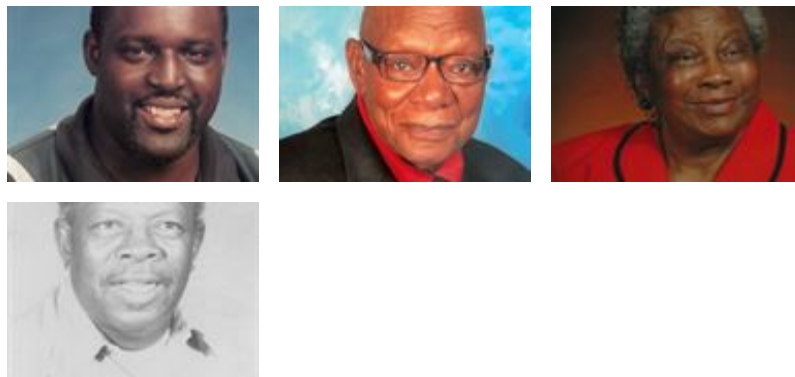

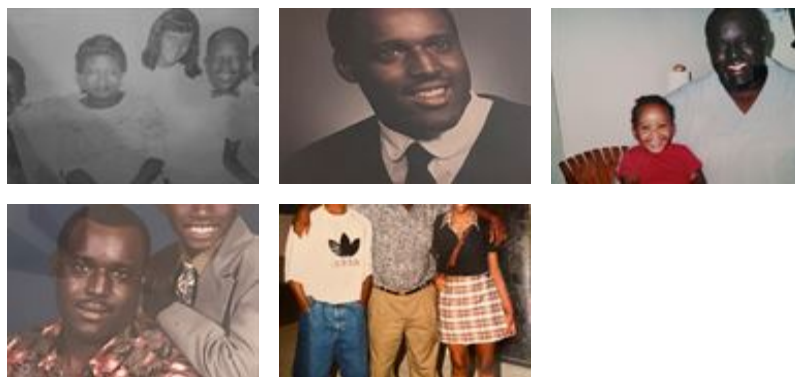
