



## Sarah Durden Jones

June 15, 1918 - October 22, 2010

North Augusta, SC—Private Graveside Services for Mrs. Sarah Durden Jones, 92, of North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest October 22, 2010 will be conducted Tuesday in the Antioch Primitive Baptist Church Cemetery, Twin City, Georgia.

Mrs. Jones was a native of Twin City, Georgia having made North Augusta her home for 58 years. She worked for 39 years at the North Augusta High School, beginning in 1953 at the old North Augusta High School on Georgia Avenue. She was a bookkeeper and secretary in the Principal's Office. Mrs. Jones was a Den Mother (Scouts), an employee of Weight Watchers, served as President of Sells Bible Class at St. John United Methodist Church, Augusta. She was Past President of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Augusta Shrine Club and served as Secretary to the National Secretaries Association, Fairways Chapter, Augusta. Mrs. Jones was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star Golden Glow Chapter #76, Grace United Methodist Church and the Stillwell Bible Class and a past volunteer at University Hospital. She was predeceased in death by her husband of 55 years, Kenneth R. Jones, Sr.

Survivors include two sons and a daughter-in-law, Kenneth R. Jones, Jr., Miami, Florida and Lewis C. Jones, Sr. and Beth H. Jones, North Augusta; one grandchild, Lewis C. Jones, Jr. (Blanchard).
