Seth was born August 12, 1986, in Accra, Ghana. He came to America at age twelve to continue his education and create a better life for his family. His love of soccer and community brought him a new family through the North Augusta Soccer Program. Seth came to live with The Franklins his freshman year in high school and became a son and brother in their hearts and lives. Seth graduated from North Augusta High School in 2005. He was involved in the community through with Grace United Methodist Church, their Youth Program, the Riverview Activities Center, and many more. He continued his education and soccer at Lander University, then transferred to Newberry College to play soccer with his brother, Jeffrey Bell. Seth graduated in the fall 2008 with a B.S.; Business Administration and finalized his United State Citizenship at the Naturalization Ceremony on the Charles Pinckney National Historic Site as he returned to his birthname to maintain dual citizenship. After establishing residence in Atlanta, Georgia, he received his Master's Degree in Business from Strayer University. He worked in the banking industry for several years becoming a business partner in Oceane Cargo Link, shipping and forwarding freight company to Ghana. He traveled between Atlanta and Ghana to build

the business and visit family. Seth truly loved soccer playing every weekend he could. Soccer was what brought him into the North Augusta community and what he loved to do the most. He continued that love until his last days. Seth was known for his big smile, kind heart, huge hugs, and love bringing joy to everyone he met.

Survivors include his North Augusta family; Kenny & Rachel Franklin, Alex Franklin, Ashley McClain (Brad) and Jeffrey Bell (Kyle); grandmother, Helen Griffin. His parents and family in Ghana, and daughter Rachel Yaa Brena Gyamfi.

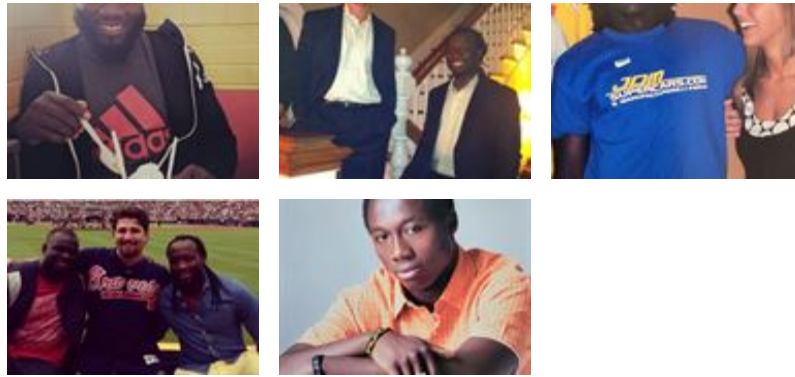

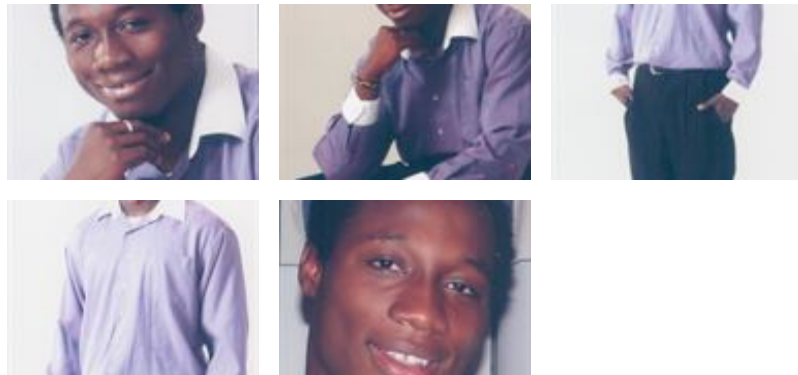
