Mr. Champagne was born March 7, 1940, to the late Ernest Felix and Peral Vicknair Champagne. He was a native of Luling, LA, raised his family in Baton Rouge, LA, and retired to North Augusta, SC, for the last 18 years.

After serving as a private in the US Army, Mr. Champagne graduated from the University of Southwestern Louisiana (USL) with a degree in Electrical Engineering. Well known for his expertise in his field, he retired from Borden Chemicals in 2001 with over 25 years of service. He will be fondly remembered for his intellect, hard work and generosity to help and mentor others.
