



Sheridan Lee Lynn

June 4, 1928 - December 5, 2021

North Augusta, SC—Memorial Services for Mr. Sheridan Lee Lynn, 93, who entered into rest December 5, 2021, will be conducted Saturday afternoon at 4 o'clock in Grace United Methodist Church. Rev. Thomas B. Wilkes, III and Dr. John M. Newell, III officiating.

Mr. Lynn was born in St. Louis, Missouri on June 4, 1928, to the late James Allen Lynn and Rose Irene Green. Moving to Sumter, South Carolina at an early age, he attended Sumter public schools and graduated from Edmunds High School. Mr. Lynn began his career in broadcasting at WFIG Radio in 1947. After nine years of radio in Sumter, Augusta, Georgia and Chattanooga, Tennessee, he began a career in television with WRDW-TV where he was known to viewers as Lee Sheridan. After 21 years at channel 12, he was hired to manage WATU-TV which became WAGT in Augusta. During his 44 years in broadcasting, Mr. Lynn took great pride in serving the community in various ways. He served on many professional and community boards and associations and was a former member of the board of directors of The Georgia Association of Broadcasters. Additionally, he served as a board member for the Salvation Army, Easter Seals, The American Cancer Society, and the Augusta Better Business Bureau.

Mr. Lynn was the recipient of The Augusta Advertising Club's Silver Medal Award, The Louis Harris Award presented by The Augusta West Rotary Club and is a Brevet Colonel in The Order of The Signal Corps. Above all, Mr. Lynn was a loving and devoted husband, father and grandfather who loved his

family dearly. He was a member of Grace United Methodist Church. Survivors include his beloved wife of 72 years, Harriet Evans Lynn; a daughter, Marjorie Anne Menk (Benjamin Johnson), Augusta, GA; three sons, The Honorable Judge Sheridan Lee "Danny" Lynn, Jr. (Patricia Hannan), North Augusta, SC, Patrick Evans "Pat" Lynn (Kathy), North Augusta, SC and Keith Allen Lynn (Ginger), Johnston, SC; 10 grandchildren, Kevin and Jackie Lynn, Jason and Rebecca Lynn, Clinton and Rachel Morgan, Casey Lynn, Peter and Lauren Menk, III, Kate and Chris Spruill, Patrick Lynn, Garrett and Ariel Lynn, Victoria and DJ Meisinger and Elizabeth Lynn; nine great-grandchildren; the extended Hannan family.
