Aiken, SC – Funeral Services for Mr. Steven Craig Sowell, 54, who entered into rest September 4, 2022, will be conducted Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock at Hillview Baptist Church. Pastor Michael McAlpin officiating. Interment will follow in Warrentville Cemetery. The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to the service from 1 until 2 o'clock.

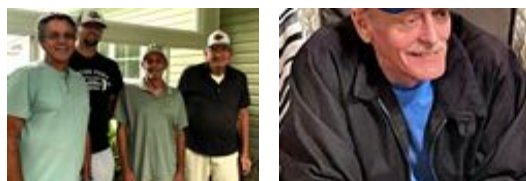

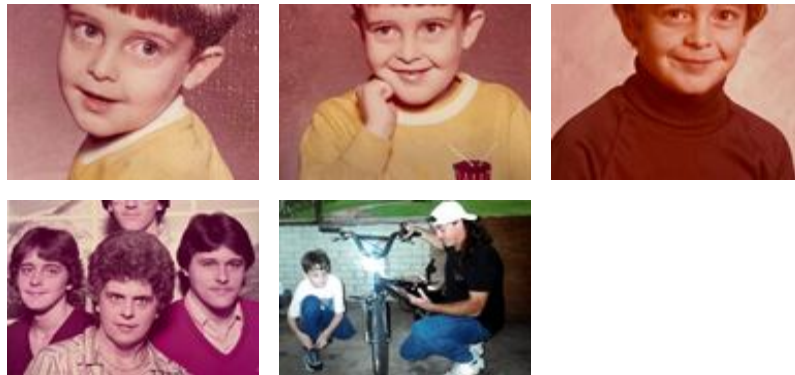
