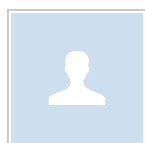

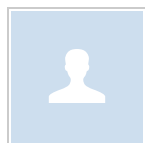

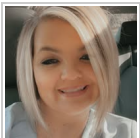


“ *Wishing Susie's Family Comfort and Peace.

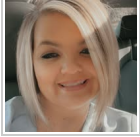
