North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Theodore Rhoden, 86, who entered into rest December 11, 2024, will be conducted this Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel. Mr. Alex Mabe officiating. A private family interment will follow.

Mr. Rhoden was a native of Johnston, South Carolina, a former resident of Martinez, Georgia, having made North Augusta his home for the past 45 years. He was a star high school athlete, having made all-state in football, baseball and basketball and was a member of the 1958 Johnston High School State Champion football team. Mr. Rhoden received a degree from Limestone College and worked as a manager at Owens Corning and as an evening administrator at Aiken Technical College. He was a long-time member of Belvedere First Baptist Church, now Warren Belvedere and was a devoted Christian. Mr. Rhoden enjoyed playing golf, watching Gamecock football and spending time with his family. He was preceded in death by his parents, Ollie and Viola Rhoden as well as his 12 siblings.

Survivors include his wife of 45 years, Carolyn Rhoden, North Augusta, SC; two daughters, Jessica (Hunter) Mottel, Lexington, SC and Terri (Billy) Monckton, Myrtle Beach, SC; five grandchildren, Will Monckton, Sydney Monckton, Sophie Kate Mottel, Luke Mottel and Parker Mottel.
