Mrs. Hayes was born September 28, 1915 in North Augusta, the only child of the late George and Louise Solomons Briggs. She was a communicant of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church, a graduate of the University of South Carolina and taught English in Guatemala City, Central America, then served as a substitute teacher in North Augusta for many years. She was a member of the Women’s Board of University Hospital, serving as a volunteer for 30 years. Mrs. Hayes was a Charter Member of the Daughters of the American Revolution Martintown Road Chapter and Regent of the chapter for three years.

Mrs. Hayes’ other activities and honors include recipient of the Golden Deeds Award from the Exchange Club of North Augusta in 1986, member of the Palmetto Garden Club, the YWCA Board of Directors, the North Augusta Heart Board and the North Augusta Council of Garden Clubs. She was the

wife of the late Mr. Paul Robert Hayes and mother of the late Paul Robert “Bob” Hayes, Jr.
