



## Theresa Annette G. Eubanks

October 5, 1932 - April 1, 2011

North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mrs. Theresa Annette G. Eubanks, 78, of Bunting Drive, North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest April 1, 2011 at home surrounded by her family and friends, will be conducted Tuesday morning at 11 o'clock from the First Baptist Church of Augusta. Annette was the daughter of Theron and Ruby Griffin and was raised in Americus, GA. After high school she went on to complete Junior College at Georgia Southwestern University. She taught elementary school until 1951 when the family moved to Beech Island, SC to seek employment with E.I. DuPont at the Savannah River Plant.

In 1957, Annette met her future husband, Reed Eubanks, at the First Baptist Church of Augusta and they became best friends. After much thought and prayer, they decided that they wanted to spend the rest of their lives together and married. They were married 45 years. She was a member of the First Baptist Church for 50 years and taught pre-teen girls Sunday School for many years.

In 1967 Annette left work at DuPont to begin a family. After her children David and Ashlyn were of school age, she returned to work at the Signal School in Fort Gordon, GA. She worked there for over 15 years, until retiring in 1991.

Annette spent her later years enjoying time with family and adoring her grandchildren, Mackenzie and Carter.

Survivors include her husband Reed M. Eubanks; a son and daughter-in-law, David and Kim Eubanks, North Augusta; a daughter and son-in-law, Ashlyn and Clay Robinson, North Augusta; two sisters Jean Owens, Newnan, GA and Barbara Eltrich, Jacksonville, FL; two grandchildren, Mackenzie Robinson and Carter Eubanks; several cousins, nieces and nephews.

The family will receive friends at the funeral home Monday evening from 5 until 7.

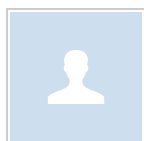

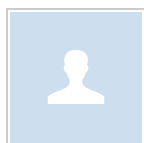
