Mr. Arnedos graduated from Cortland State University in NY in 1973 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Public Health and later received his Masters degree from the University of Oklahoma in 1975. He served 34 years with the Palm Beach County Health Department, the last ten years of those years as the department's Assistant Director and retired in 2013. Sir Knight Thomas Arnedos was a member of the global Catholic fraternal service order, Knights of Columbus, for many years. He has served as a past Grand Knight and Treasurer.

An honorable man with a passion for life, he could be found either cycling on the Greenway or playing tennis. He was a loving and respectful Husband, and a loving and guiding Father. Friends were treasures to be appreciated and

cared for. He was a devout Catholic, which always guided his way.
