In his retirement, he trained professionally as a caddy and worked at the Augusta National Golf Club, caddying throughout the year for members. He was preceded in death his wife, Virginia Green Machak; three brothers, Mark Machak, George Machak and Steve Machak; two sisters, Barbara Toth and
