Belvedere, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Timothy M. Hegler, 72, who entered into rest March 25, 2014, will be conducted Friday morning at 11 o'clock from the Belvedere First Baptist Church. Rev. Tim was a native of Rock Hill, South Carolina, a former resident of Augusta, having made Belvedere his home for the past 49 years. He was a member of Belvedere First Baptist Church and Frank Buck's Victory Sunday School Class. Tim was a 1959 graduate of Richmond Academy and a U.S Navy Veteran who served aboard the USS Randolph Aircraft Carrier. He was a member of the Jesse C. 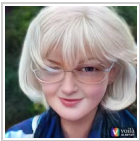
