North Augusta, SC – Graveside Services for Mr. Vernon Davis Verdery, Sr., 94, who entered into rest June 7, 2018, will be conducted Monday morning at 10 o'clock in Sunset Hill Cemetery with Veteran Honors. Pastor Bob Gosey officiating. The family will receive friends at the funeral home Sunday evening from 5 until 7 o'clock.

Mr. Verdery was a lifelong resident of North Augusta, a member of First Baptist Church of North Augusta and was retired from CSX Railroad with over 43 years of service. He was an Army Air Corps veteran of World War II and the Korean War, having served in the reserves and active duty. Mr. Verdery was an active member of the Jessie C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71 and served on the board of trustees of Seaboard Systems Credit Union. He enjoyed gardening and sharing what he grew with friends and family. Mr. Verdery was a last surviving of nine siblings.

Additionally, he was preceded in death by his wife, Helen Hood Verdery; a son, Vernon Davis Verdery, Jr.; and a son-in-law, Allan Blake DeVaney.

Survivors include, a daughter, Brenda Verdery-DeVaney; a son, John (Robyn) Verdery; two grandchildren, Elizabeth Helen Verdery, Samantha Ford DeVaney; a great-grandchild, Aidan DeVaney Quinn.

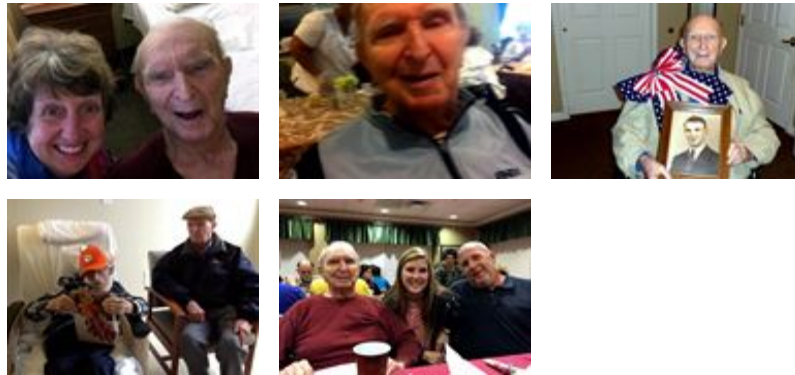
