North Augusta, SC—Funeral services for Mrs. Virginia H. Douglas, 79, of Carolina Avenue, North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest March 7, 2008, will be conducted Monday afternoon at 3 o'clock from Curtis Baptist Church. Rev. W. Sherrell Dunn officiating. Interment in Morgantown Family Cemetery, Springfield, SC.

Mrs. Douglas was a native of Charlotte, NC having made North Augusta her home for the past 53 years. She was a member of Curtis Baptist Church where she taught piano and art in the Curtis School, a former Sunday School teacher, member of the Nancy Wilcox Sunday School Class and Gideon International Auxillary. Mrs. Douglas was the Owner-Director of Virginia Douglas School of Art on Porcelian at Bonclarken, Flat Rock, NC for 37 years and Lake Yale, FL for 20 years.

Survivors include her husband of 53 years, John L. Douglas; three sisters, Margaret H. Shaver, League City, TX, Vera H. Stegall, Huntersville, NC and Mary H. Walters, Charlotte, NC.
