Jackson, SC—Funeral Services for Mrs. Vivian “Dimples” Bryant, 99, who entered into rest January 26, 2019, will be conducted Tuesday morning at 11 o’clock from the First Baptist Church of Jackson. Reverend Marion Britton officiating. Interment in Jackson Memorial Park.

Mrs. Bryant was a native of Lincolnton, Georgia, a former resident of Ellenton, South Carolina, having made Jackson her home for the past 67 years. She was a Charter Member of the First Baptist Church of Jackson and a member of the Philathea Sunday School Class. Mrs. Bryant retired from the University Hospital Physical Therapy Department with 24 years of service. She was predeceased by her husband, Alvin Duff Bryant and her parents, Frank and Leila Dallis.

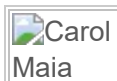

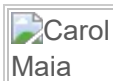

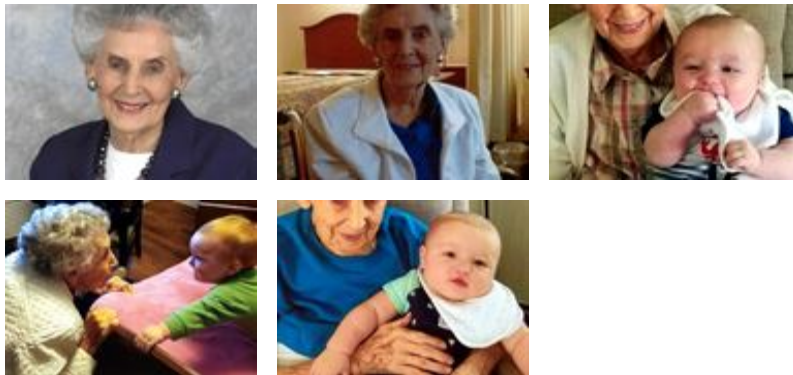
