



Wallace "Hawpaw" McCluggage

May 3, 1941 - March 18, 2023

North Augusta, SC – Mr. Wallace “Hawpaw” McCluggage, 81, entered into rest March 18, 2023, at his home. Memorial Services will be conducted and announced at a later date.

Wallace was born May 3, 1941, to the late Walter Thomas and Vona Floy Hughes McCluggage. He was raised in Lawrenceburg, TN, was a former resident of Nashville, TN, having made North Augusta, SC his home for the past 34 years. Wallace was a U.S. Air Force veteran of the Vietnam War and he retired from the Savannah River Site with 36 years of service. He loved listening to smooth jazz, was an avid Tennessee Volunteers fan and enjoyed the outdoors. However, his greatest pride and joy in life was the time he spent with family, who affectionately called him “Hawpaw.” His grandchildren were most important to him, and he cherished every moment he had with them.
