North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Mr. Wayne Phillips, 73, who entered into rest April 15, 2025, will be conducted Friday afternoon, April 25th, at 3 o'clock in the Posey Funeral Chapel with Veteran Honors. Wayne was born July 1, 1951, to the late Joe Gilbert Phillips and Bessie Reese Phillips Bone. He was raised in Augusta, GA, having made North Augusta, SC his home for 27 years. Wayne was a car enthusiast and had a great passion for collecting and showing antique cars. However, his most recent passion was the 2020 Ford Mustang he acquired. Wayne was a man of faith with a generous heart. He was a larger-than-life personality and never met a stranger. Wayne's greatest joy in life was his family. He adored his children and grandchildren, and his best friend was his beloved wife, Juanita. Wayne was affectionately known by his wife, family and friends alike as "Big Daddy." He was proud to celebrate the accomplishments and milestones of those he loved. Wayne took an active interest in the things that were important to his wife, and he made sure that through his words and actions, Juanita never doubted his love for her. He will be fondly remembered for his determination in his approach to life and the great love he had for others.

In addition to his parents, Wayne was preceded in death by his first wife, Sharon Lynne Phillips; two brothers, James Dempsey Phillips and Bobby Dean Phillips; a sister, Wilda
