North Augusta, SC—Dr. Wilfred "Will" Bowman, 69, of Holliday Drive, entered into rest May 19, 2011. The family will receive friends to celebrate his life Thursday, May 26, 2011 at the funeral home from 5 until 7.

Dr. Bowman was a native of Troy, OH, having made North Augusta his home for the past 38 years. He was a graduate of Wilmington College, received his Doctorate of Nuclear Physical Chemistry from the University of Rochester and served his Post Doctoral Fellowship at Texas A&M University. Dr. Bowman was a retired Nuclear Chemist at the Savannah River Laboratory with over 30 years of service. He was an active supporter and Past President of the North Augusta High School Band Boosters and upon retirement was an active volunteer at Pendleton King Park.
