



## William "Bill" Skinner Boynton

Belvedere, SC – Memorial Services for Mr. William “Bill” Skinner Boynton, 97, who entered into rest June 10, 2024, will be conducted Tuesday afternoon, June 18th, at 2 o’clock at Fairview Presbyterian Church with Dr. Allen M. Thompson officiating. Interment will immediately follow in the church columbarium. The family will receive friends in the church fellowship hall following the interment.

Bill was born April 5, 1927, to the late Evander Ashton Boynton, Sr. and Dorothy Skinner Boynton. He was raised in Walterboro, SC, and graduated in 1944 from the Carlisle Military School, Bamberg, SC. Bill was a proud patriot and a U.S. Navy veteran, serving his country during the World War II era. He retired from DuPont as a foreman with over 35 years of service. Bill was a man of many talents, who could design and fix anything. He dedicated much of his life to the hobby of radio-controlled airplanes, building magnificent airplanes, and found immense joy in piloting his aircraft. Bill enjoyed the simple things in life; fishing, water skiing, camping, and traveling. However, his greatest joy was his family. He will be fondly remembered for his unfailing love for his wife, children, and grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Evander Ashton Boynton, Jr., and a sister, Dorothy Boynton Carnie. Surviving family members left to cherish his memory include his beloved wife of 67 years,

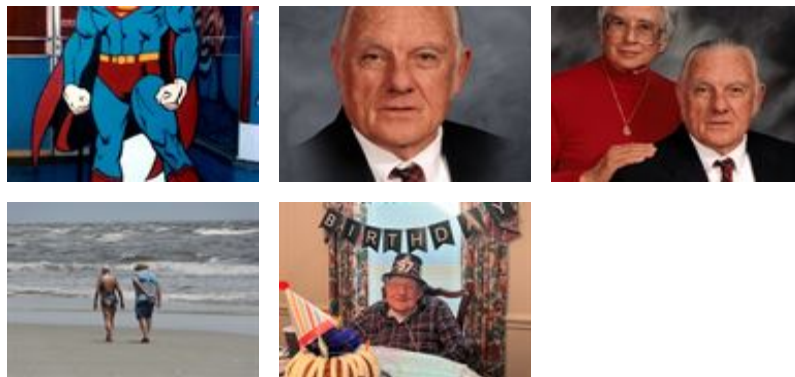
