Mr. Brannen was a native of Statesboro, Georgia having made Beech Island his home for the past 60 years. Mr. Brannen enjoyed fishing, hunting and gardening and was known for his life quotes, his favorite being, "Give 110% to everything you do." He was tapped for a University of Georgia Football Scholarship by Coach Wall Butts before graduating but was drafted into the US Army during World War II.
