Mr. Coe was born March 29, 1960, in Philadelphia, PA to the late William and Jean Coe. He served his country in the United States Army. Mr. Coe was an avid NASCAR fan, Alabama football fan, enjoyed participating in living history reenactments and owner of six beloved rescue cats.
