North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Mr. William Thomas Taylor, 94, who entered into rest April 30, 2022, will be conducted Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock in the Posey Funeral Chapel with Full Military Honors. Dr. T. Joseph Lusk officiating. The family will receive friends at the funeral home one hour prior to the service from 1 until 2 o'clock. Interment will be held at a later date in the Grace United Methodist Church Columbarium.

Mr. Taylor was born on November 15, 1927, in North Augusta, SC, to the late William Thomas Taylor, Sr. and Mary McCarthy Taylor. He was a U.S. Navy veteran of World War II, retiring with 21 years of service to his country. Mr. Taylor was a member of Grace United Methodist Church and was an avid outdoorsman.
