



## Wm. Otis Pou, Jr.

April 19, 1929 - November 2, 2024

Jackson, SC – Funeral Services for Mr. Wm. Otis Pou, Jr., 95, who entered into rest November 2, 2024, will be conducted Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock from Matlock Baptist Church. Rev. Dale Reeves and Dr. Mark Riser officiating. Interment will follow in Jackson Memorial Park. The family will receive friends at the funeral home Wednesday evening from 5 until 8 o'clock.

A native of Jackson, SC, Otis was born April 19, 1929, to the late William Otis Pou, Sr. and Mary Alice Wren Pou. He graduated with honors from Ellenton High School and was a life-long member of Matlock Baptist Church, where he served as Sunday School Secretary. Otis served in the Georgia National Guard and in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict. He was a member of the American Legion Post 92 and the Silverton Agricultural Club. Otis was co-founder of K&P Auto Machine Shop, with his friend and business partner, the late James H. Kell.

In addition to his parents, Otis was preceded in death by his wife Mildred K. Pou. Surviving family members include two sons, William O. "Billy" Pou, III (Jackie) and Lawrence Riley (Sherry); five grandchildren, Sammy Pou (Tori), Summer Riley, Justin Maguire (Audri), Allison Barry, and Lee Harper; nine great-grandchildren, Tanner Howell, Jaycee Mitchell, Isabell Pou, Kaden Carr, Addison Pou, Kalynn Pou, Brennan Pou, Emily Harper, and Michael Harper.

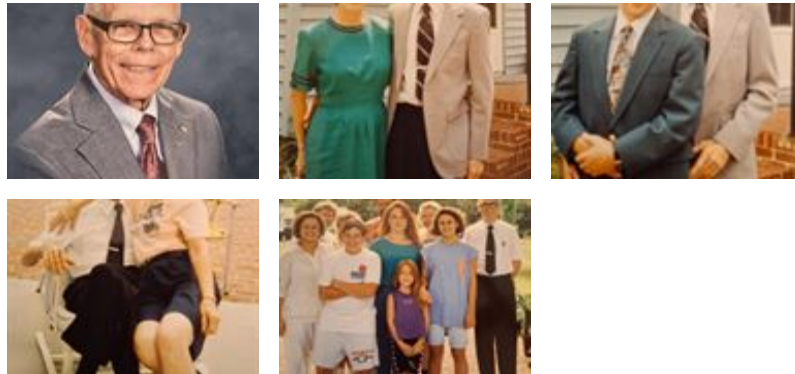
